

***BATRACHYLA NIBALDOI*** (Nibaldo's Wood frog). CHILE: X REGION DE LOS LAGOS: Quinchao, Isla Alao (42° 35'S, 73° 16'W, 114 m altitude), approximately 6 km N of Isla Chaulinec. 13 and 18 February 2001. L. Iriarte. Museo Nacional de Historia Natural, Santiago, Chile (MNHN-3422 and 3421). Verified by H. Núñez. Collected on mosses in a Chilean Valdivian rain forest. First record from X Administrative Region of Chile. Species previously known in Chile from Puente Traihuanca (Formas, 1997, *Herpetologica* 53 (1): 6-13), and later extend distribution at Laguna San Rafael National Park (Díaz-Páez and Williams, 2001, *Herpetological Review* 32(4): 189) and Las Guaitecas National Reserve (Díaz-Páez and Carreño, *Herpetological Review* 33(3): 218). New country record; extends the northern range of this species on the N - W by ca. 360 Km from Puente Traihuanca
