

Ecophysiology of Photosynthesis: Theoretical and Practical Approaches

The eligibility requirements for applicants are:

1. To be a student of a graduate program at a University or research center.
2. To have financial support for travel expenses (fellowships do not include international or national travel; only course materials, food, and lodging are included in the fellowship).
3. To have English and Spanish oral and reading comprehension.
4. Basic background in Plant Physiology at the undergraduate level.
5. Since there is only a small number of fellowships, having full financial support from your home country or international sources may increase your chances of being accepted for the course.

The application for admittance in the course should include:

- a) Filled application form
- b) Cover letter: explaining your interest in the course and the relationship of this course with your present or future thesis work. In this letter, the applicant should state how well the eligibility requirements are met.
- c) Recommendation letter of your advisor (should state how the student met the eligibility requirements).
- d) Curriculum vitae
